FROM THE HEADTEACHER .....

This week has been reminiscent of life before Covid with our Year 6 pupils sitting their practice SATs in the hall. Many of our children have been undertaking assessments. This is really helping teachers to establish exactly where children are in their learning and will enable planning for next steps after Easter. Teachers are looking forward to meeting families next Wednesday and Thursday during parents evening, to report children's progress. It's not too late to sign up for an appointment with your child's teacher using SchoolPing. Well done to all of our children who have conducted themselves so well during this assessment period.

## **COVID CASES**

We have had 3 recorded cases of Covid in school this week. One child and adult member in Year 5, one child in Year 4 and one child in Year 6. If your child is unwell and displays any of the main symptoms of Covid then they may well have contracted the virus. To avoid the spread we would appreciate it if anyone with symptoms gets a PCR test and doesn't send their child to school until they have produced negative LFD tests on 2 consecutive days, no earlier than day 5. Children who live with someone with Covid-19 should still attend their setting as normal unless they develop symptoms or test positive. We have just resumed being able to be together as a whole school and would love to keep it that way! Thank you!

#### **RED NOSE DAY**


