Thank you for showing an interest in our vacancy. I hope that the following information will be of help to you in helping you decide whether to apply for the position.

Christ Church Primary School is situated close to the town centre of Weston-super-Mare. The school is housed in a Victorian building. Throughout its history the school has had close links with the local church, Christ Church, and this is still very much the case. Christ Church became an Academy in September 2017, and is now part of the Kaleidoscope MAT, along with 6 other local primary schools.

Our vision - 'Let Your Light Shine', underpins who we are and what we do. We challenge and inspire every child to reach their full potential by providing a creative curriculum that supports each child's individual needs. We aim to do this by providing a wide variety of educational experiences that help them in their spiritual, moral and social development as well as achieving at a high academic level.

Although the school is limited by its physical environment, there is a strong family atmosphere and Christian ethos. There are approximately 204 children on roll at present, within a one-form entry system. The majority of the children live within the vicinity of the school.

The school is led by me, Emma Bray, assisted by Deputy Headteacher, Rachael Clarke. In addition we have 5 full time teaching staff and 4 part time teachers. The teaching staff are currently supported by Teaching Assistants, a Learning Mentor, a Lunchtime Learning Mentor and a small team of Learning Support Assistants who work with SEN children. PPA time is covered in house. Our office is manned by 3 staff.

We are looking for an excellent TA to join our happy team. The post is temporary until 31 March 2023 and could possibly continue depending on staffing restructure.

The closing date for applications is noon on Friday, 4 March and the interview date is planned to be week commencing 7 March. Visits to the school by prospective applicants are encouraged and can be arranged through the school office. Please ensure you include an e mail and mobile number for your two referees.
