STARS OF THE WEEK

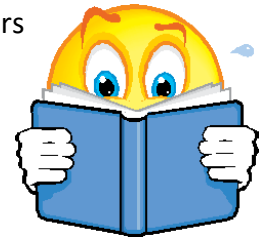
Our child 'Star' is given to Honey in Year 3 for improved efforts in showing our school values! Great work Honey, keep it up!
