

Year Group: EYFS Term: 3

Project Title: Traditional Tales

This project explores a variety of traditional tales and other stories. The children will be learning what elements traditional tales have, such as a magical setting, talking animals, good and evil characters, and a happy ending. We will discuss the beginning, middle and end of stories and how the writer keeps the reader interested.



Understanding the world

We will be learning about celebrations from around the world (Holi, Chinese New Year, Nowruz).

We will be looking at different geographical features we can find in Weston and using a map of the school to find our way round.

Literacy:

We will be learning to write sentences using our rainbow model of "who and what" with the addition of where and when.

E.g. — the cat is sleeping on the bed at night.

Mathematics

We will be learning about numbers to 10 (count, add, subtract) and using 10 frames/Numicon to support this learning.

Phonics

Learning the sounds in Phase 2 and 3 forming letters, verbal sounds, CVC words.

Sharing our news and things that we have done.

Becoming experts in colour and the use of different techniques.

We will be learning to:

Think about healthy eating and exercise .
